Year Level 5 – 7


You will need:

- Handout "A Day to remember"
- 'Snapshots of War' kit
- Assorted lead pencils

Instructions:

1. Discuss the photographs in the kit, drawing out ideas about, the experiences, sights sounds etc.
2. Have student choose 1 photograph to draw from.
3. Students then focus on one small aspect and using the lead pencils draw the character they have chosen to represent.
4. After students have completed their drawings, discuss the theme "A Day to remember" from the point of view of the character in their drawing.
5. Have them brainstorm the "SHOW" eg. Sights, sounds, smells, tastes, textures, emotions that they might experience.
6. Then using a "sizzling Start" write a memory or diary entry from the point of view of the character in the picture.
7. Edit and publish the work accompanied by the drawing.
