



## Banjo and Ruby Red

### Handprint Chooks

You will need:

- Cover paper in suitable colours
- Collage materials, corrugated card, feathers, bark, textured papers etc.
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencils for drawing

1. Have class work in pairs to trace around each other's hand.
2. Assist children to draw a beak shape on the 'thumb', then cut around outline of the "Chook"
3. Use a selection of collage materials to collage the chook shape.
4. Display on Farmyard Mural.

Rubbings:

You will need:

- Collaged chooks
  - Light drawing paper
  - Crayons or rubbing blocks
  - Scissors
  - glue
1. Using a sheet of paper and crayons or a rubbing block, place the paper over the collaged chook. Rubbing gently to create a patterned rubbing.
  2. Cut carefully around the rubbing and glue to farmyard mural
