You will need:

- Reduced (A5 size) copy of colouring sheet from webpage

 - Soft drawing chalks
 - Collage materials (laces ribbons etc)
 - Lace collage papers
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - Cover paper in soft colours (A5)
1. Read and discuss the book and how the illustrations are made. Make connections to when the students were babies or if they have a baby at home.
 2. Use the pastels in 3 colours only to colour the mother and baby. Use fingers to blend and smudge the colours. Cut around the elephants.
 3. Select a colour background that enhances the coloured picture.
 4. Using the collage printed paper and other materials, make a collage of Baby's Bedtime.
