



## Clucking Chook

Peggy by Anna Walker

You will need:

- Paper cup
- Piece of kitchen sponge
- String (Curling ribbon works well)
- Matchstick
- Feathers
- Scrap of red felt
- Joggle eyes
- Scrap of yellow card or felt
- Glue



Instructions

1. Cut a piece of string to length and tie a piece of sponge to the end.
2. Pierce the bottom of the cup and thread the string through the hole knotting it around the matchstick to prevent it pulling through.
3. Use scraps of red felt or paper to make wattles and comb, glue in place.
4. Glue on eyes and yellow felt or paper scraps for beak
5. Glue on feathers for wings
6. To get clucking, use sponge and pull down string in jerky movements.
