



Dream Catcher

You will need:

- 1 paper plate
- Lengths of wool (approx. 1 metre)
- Feathers
- Beads
- Sticky tape
- Glue
- Hole punch (plier type)

Instructions:

1. Pre-cut a large circular hole in each plate and punch eight holes evenly spaced around edge. On top edge punch a single hole in centre, and three extra holes at the bottom. (See diagram)
2. Secure a piece of wool to back of plate and weave through all eight holes, creating a 'spider web' pattern.
3. Tape to secure.
4. Using another length of coloured wool, thread through one of the lower holes and thread on beads and feathers, knotting to keep beads in place. Feathers may be knotted, taped or glued to secure. Complete the other two holes in the same way.
5. Add a small loop of wool through the top hole to hang.
