

# Elephant House

Too Many Elephants in this House

You will need:

- Triple wall card (small corrugations) 10 x 27.5 cm (Fishpond cardboard single book packaging will make about 4 this size)
- Circle of firm card 10 cm diameter
- Felt pens
- Cutting knife, Stanley knife
- Scissors
- PVA glue
- Ruler
- Split paper pin
- Scraps of paper, card, felt for roof.



Instructions:

1. Cut out card circle and using felt pens draw and colour as many elephants as possible.
2. Mark centre of circle and make a hole.
3. Fold Triple wall card to make a thin house shape approx. 10.5 – 11 cm wide.
4. Open out house shape and draw on windows and a door.
5. Cut the windows along 3 sides to open out.
6. Cut a window in the door on all 4 sides, but DO NOT cut door to open.
7. Colour or paint house as desired.
8. Mark hole in door for split pin.
9. Push split pin through door and circle of elephants with the elephants being visible through the door and windows. Secure in place.
10. Glue open flaps of the house at the back.
11. Cut paper or felt for roof and glue in place – allow to dry.
