



## Family Tree Collage

Discuss families and different groups eg, school family, sport family, etc.

One meaning of the word family is: any group of related things

You will need:

- Paperbark or scrapbooking papers with a bark print
- A4 Cover paper for background
- Paper for leaves A5
- Pens
- Glue
- scissors

Instructions:

1. Tear bark design paper into shreds and glue to background in a tree shape. By careful tearing, a realistic picture can be created.
2. Write the names of your family on the leaves (one name per leaf)
3. Cut out the leaves and attach them to the tree branches with a dab of glue. Allowing the leaves to stick out from the background.
4. Arrange the leaves with the oldest members of your family at the bottom of the branches and youngest at the top of the branches. Alternately make yourself the trunk.

Hint: Have the class experiment with tearing different types of paper first for practice, as you can create different effects in the way that you tear it.
