

Field of Poppies

A Day to Remember by Jackie French illustrated by Mark Wilson

Year 3-7

You will need:

- Poppy Pattern
- Red paper or
- Red colours – felt pen, pencil, paint, crayons etc.
- Small piece of black crepe paper
- Pipe cleaner (green)
- Tape scissors
- Glue (PVA)

Instructions

1. Print pattern onto red paper or colour poppies if printed on white paper
2. Cut out poppy petals 1 large 1 small for each poppy
3. Crease along folds on petals
4. Cut small circle from black paper and fringe edges
5. Make a hole in centre of all 3 pieces
6. Layering the petals and centre, push the pipecleaner, through the hole and bend over and secure in place.
7. Tape or a dab of a small amount of glue can be used to hold the petals in place.
8. Using Monet's "Field of Poppies" for inspiration, display completed poppies on a large background field.
