



Ladder Hopscotch & Tor Making

Make a ladder to climb and rescue the cat.
Make your own cat tor to use on the way.

You will need:

- Dyed newspaper
- Stapler
- Smooth stones (Buy in bags from garden shops)
- Paint
- Brushes
- Toy Cat

1. Distribute one smooth stone per student.
2. Have students paint stones to resemble cats.
3. Allow to dry.
4. Roll individual sheets of newspaper into small thin rolls.
5. Join newspaper rolls to make a ladder shape – staple together.
6. Lay ladder shapes flat on ground.
7. Place Toy cat at top of ladder
8. Toss tor and start hopping.
9. Hop to tor square and toss again, continue until you reach the cat. Rescue the cat and hop back. Remembering to collect your tor as well.

Ladders can be made as long as you like, but shorter ladders would be better for younger children. Children could work in small groups and make a variety of ladder lengths.

We used poster Paint pens to make the cat faces on the stones.
