



Metal Door Panels

You will need:

- metal shim approx. 12x12 cm (one for each student) – one roll will be enough for a class of 25.
- Sharp pencil (HB or 2H or harder)
- Newspaper pads for each child or a cutting mat
- Drawing template
- Stylus or wooden chopsticks, popsticks, or orange sticks
- Contrasting colour card for mounting
- Hot glue gun or double sided tape

1. Draw design on the drawing template.
2. Tape the template to the metal (front side)
3. Place metal on newspaper pad and pressing hard trace over the lines of the drawing.
4. Decide which parts of the drawing should stand out from the background.
5. Turn over the metal and use the orange stick to gently rub the parts to stand out. Working on the newspaper pad to prevent flattening the metal work.
6. Work alternately from front and back to achieve desired results.
7. Mount on coloured card to display.
