You will need:

- 1 A4 sheet of black cover paper with 2 copies of the pattern
- Scraps of red paper for comb and wattles
- Scraps of yellow paper for beak
- Stapler
- Feathers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Goggle eyes
- Light coloured pencil (white or pale yellow)

Instructions:

1. Cut out both body and wing parts. (Colour before cutting if using white card)
2. Fold along line on both pieces of body.
3. Glue scraps of paper for wattles, comb and beak onto back of one shape.
4. Glue the top part of the chicken (above the fold) together sandwiching the comb etc. between the two pieces.
5. Draw feather patterns on the wings and glue wings one to each side of the body.
6. Glue on a feather for the tail
7. Add eyes (one to each side).
8. Open out body slightly to sit Peggy.
