You will need:

- Pictures of city skylines (Google earth)
- A6 cover paper or heavy card – printed with POSTCARD on back
- Newspaper, scrapbooking paper
- Stay anywhere pen
- Old stamps
- Poster colours or dyes
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Have class look at different city skylines. Choose a city to depict (use a familiar landmark) e.g. Sydney – Harbour Bridge, Brisbane – City Hall etc.
2. Use newspaper and other papers to create a skyline
3. Glue paper onto card, use fineline marker to add detail to skyline collage.
4. Use paints to colour your city scene
