



## Viking Shield

You will need:

- Large uncoated paper plate (23cm wide)
- Flatter plates you will have to follow Steps 1, 2 and 3
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Paints
- Metallic crayons or paint
- Strips of card
- pencil

1. Cut into the centre of the paper plate if necessary
2. Lap over the cut edge to make a shallow cone or shield shape.
3. Staple the overlap to make a shield shape
4. Draw a suitable pattern or design features on the top of the shield
5. Colour the design, adding metallic colour where the shield would be reinforced with metal.
6. Allow to dry.
7. Attach a paper strip to the back as a handle.
